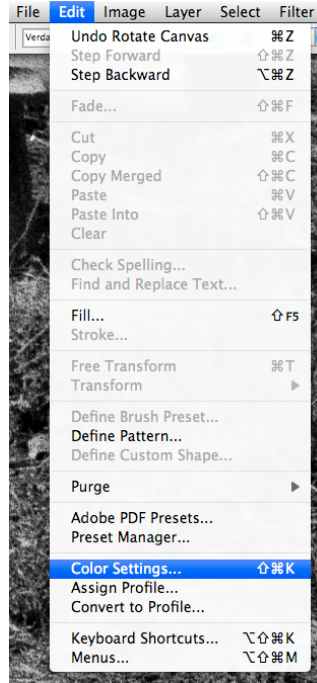
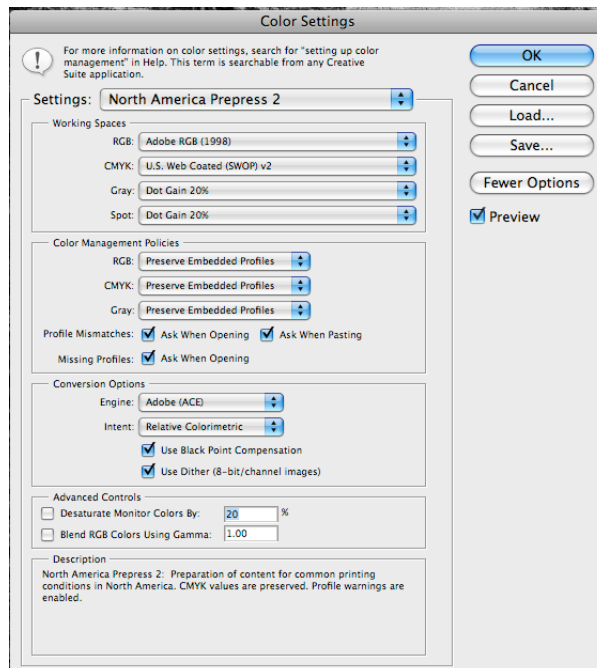


Color Settings Setup for Photoshop - For Best Use with Lightroom

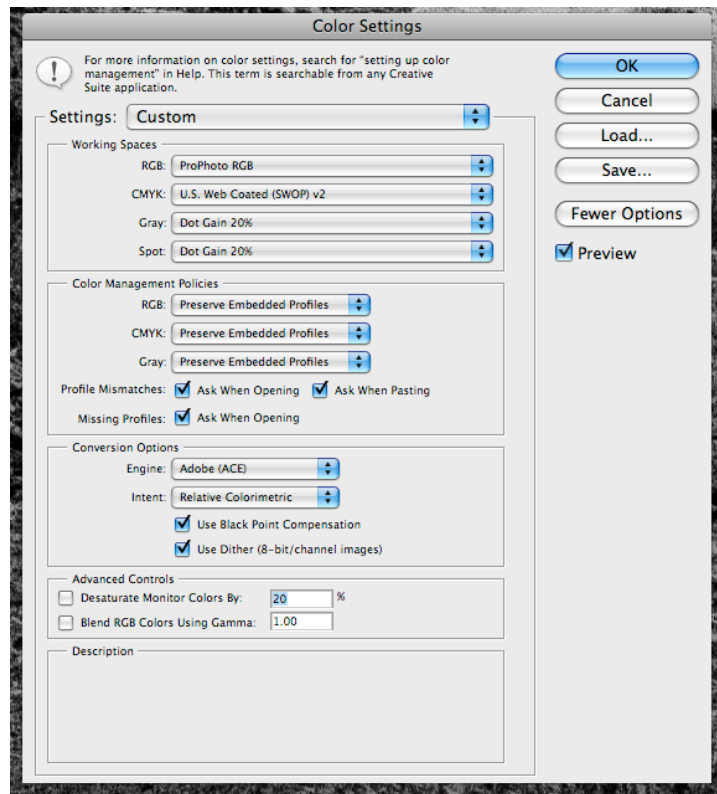
Use the Color Settings command found in the Edit menu:



Pick the North American Pre-press two bundle from the popup menu:



then modify the Working Spaces RGB setting for ProPhoto RGB:



NOTE:

The use of ProPhoto RGB implies that you are editing with 16bit per channel files. ProPhoto RGB color space cannot be used for 8bit files.

If for some reason you must use 8bit per channel files (*for example: a plug-in that you need to use will only allow 8bit files*), then the proper thing to do is to

- convert the file to Adobe RGB color space, then
- re-set the bit depth to 8bit.

This preserves the maximum amount of data and reduces clipping.
